

Welcome to the first Horn peep show!

Behind a small red velvet curtain 10 young laughing faces are greeting us with their infectious enthusiasm. These faces belong to ten artists from ten Eastern European countries.

After an interruption of one year KulturKontakt Austria has once again invited artists to the art and studio house in Horn for a one month stay. Following the tradition of the last symposia we have decided for a single theme and medium photography.

KulturKontakt has supported many programs for fine artists since its beginning, where however photography has hardly found any consideration. Not because this medium has been outside of our grant programs but rather because we have not received any applications from photographers. Why this was so we have not been able to clarify, and this in addition to the fact that Eastern European has a long and rich history of photography as art. We regret that we do not know more about this. However we wanted to make up for this by providing studios to young artists in Vienna and dedicate this years symposium in Horn to photography.

Our competition resulted in 121 applications

from 21 East-European states. The jury had a most difficult task choosing ten artists, when there were many who would have deserved to receive a grant as well. I want to thank all competitors for their interest for through their work we could see how varied, interesting and exciting the photography scene has become on the reform states.

I want to thank the members of the jury, Vaclav Macek/Fotofo Bratislava, Bacha Malazonia/ photographer from Tbilissi, Gudrun Schreiber/ BKA art department Vienna and Josef Wais/ artist Vienna. Toni Kurz/gallery director and Ludwig Polesny from the Photography Club in Horn were not only members of the jury, but they also looked after our guests as well.

In addition I want to thank my colleague, Dr. Nicole Marjanovic-Zoubek, who accompanied these programs in a most exemplary manner. Mr. Grassinger and Mr. Zirngast, who are responsible for the house, have also seen to it that everything ran smoothly and efficiently.

So I can only say that the entire program was a wonderful experience for all of us.

Willkommen bei der 1. Horner Peep Show! Hinter einem kleinen roten Samtvorhang versteckt lachen uns 10 junge Gesichter entgegen. Sie gehören 10 Fotokünstlern aus 10 osteuropäischen Ländern.

KulturKontakt Austria hat nach einem Jahr der Unterbrechung 1998 wieder Künstler ins Kunstund Atelierhaus nach Horn zu einem einmonatigen Aufenthalt eingeladen. Folgend der Tradition der letzten Symposien haben wir uns wieder für ein Thema bzw. Medium entschieden, - der Fotografie.

KulturKontakt hat seit seiner Gründung sehr viele Programme für bildende Künstler unterstützt, die Fotografie fand jedoch kaum Berücksichtigung. Dies jedoch nicht, weil wir dieses Medium aus unserem Förderungsprogramm ausgeklammert hätten - es gingen kaum Ansuchen von Fotografen bei uns ein. Warum das so war wissen wir nicht und konnten wir auch nie klären. Noch dazu, wo es gerade in Osteuropa eine reiche und lange Geschichte der künstlerischen Fotografie gibt, auch der experimentellen. Mit Beschämung müssen wir einmal mehr feststellen, wie wenig wir auch darüber wissen. Wir wollten dieser Tradition nun insofern Rechnung tragen, als wir 1997 ein Atelier für junge Fotokünstler in Wien schufen und das diesjährige Symposion in Horn der Fotografie widmen.

Unserer Ausschreibung folgten 121 Fotografen aus 21 osteuropäischen Staaten. Für die Jury war die Auswahl nicht leicht, wesentlich mehr Künstler als die letztlich erwählten zehn hätten verdient eingeladen zu werden. Ich möchte mich bei allen Bewerbern sehr herzlich für ihr Interesse bedanken. Durch ihre Arbeiten konnten wir einen guten Eindruck davon bekommen, wie vielfältig, interessant und spannend die Foto-Szene in den Reformstaaten ist.

Bedanken möchte ich mich bei den Jurymitgliedern - Vaclac Macek/Fotofo - Imago, Bacha Malazonia/Fotograf aus Tbilissi, Gudrun Schreiber/BKA Kunstsektion und Josef Wais/Künstler - Fotogalerie WuK. Toni Kurz/Galerist und Ludwig Polesny vom Fotoclub Horn waren nicht nur in der Jury, sie haben unsere Gäste auch auf das Beste betreut.
